This means that sunset on February 2, 2022 marks the beginning of the new month. Be sure to keep track of what number month this is, based on when you started the new year. The photo at the top of this report was taken from our observation point in Jerusalem this evening (we did not see the new moon).

On behalf of all of us who rely on these observations, we wish to thank everyone who looked for the new moon this evening and sent in their observations in a timely manner, and everyone supporting our efforts from afar. Thanks to our combined efforts, we are able to provide reliable New Moon observations each month from the Land of Israel.
