It's that time of the month when we like to remind all of you faithful observers in Israel, to please look for the new moon this coming **Wednesday evening**, 22 March 202.

It's important we look for the crescent New Moon at the end of the month, because that's the sign the new month has begun (Gen 1:14). In fact, that's why a month in Hebrew is called "chodesh", which comes from the root ch.d.sh., which means "new", because the moon is seen anew at the beginning of the month (1 Samuel 20:5;24 Psalm 81:4[3]; Eziekiel 46:1). It's also important that we sight the New Moon from Israel, because that's where the commandments are to be kept from (Dt 16:1). The beginning of the month and the beginning of the year need to be set from Israel.

As always, we will be sharing whether we saw the New Moon following the observation, so be sure to <u>subscribe</u> to our e-mail list and social media platforms, so you don't miss that report.
