As days in the Biblical Calendar are from sunset to sunset, Rosh Chodesh (the first day of the month), begins when the New Moon has been sighted and continues until sunset the following day. Rosh Chodesh a celebratory day (Num 10:10; Hosea 2:11), which was traditionally commemorated by blowing the shofar (Num 10:10; Psalm 81:4[3]), having a festive meal (1 Samuel 20:5, 24), and worshiping at the Beit HaMikdash (Temple) (Isaiah 66:23;

Ezekiel 46:3) with a special sacrifice (Num 28:11-15; 2Chronicles 2:3; Ezra 3:4-5, Ezekiel 45:17, Ezekiel 46:6).

Are you planning on inspecting the fields again?

Seeing how when we inspected the fields on the 7thand 8th days of the last Hebrew month, a lot of the fields were still not Aviv, and those in the Jordan Valley (Joshua 5:10-12) and the Beit Shean regions, and we had much heavy rain, some of you asked whether we could organize another inspection next week. Although it's very expensive every time we go out, we are going to try to make this happen, and hope to be able to send you that report on May 1, 2023 (the 10thday of the Hebrew month). Please pray for our safety and guidance and <u>support</u> this upcoming Barley Inspection.
