And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for appointed times, and for days and years. (Gen 1:14)




Dear Friends,

We just got back from looking for the New Moon on **6 July 2024**, and at the time of this writing, we aren't aware of any positive naked eye sightings from this evening's observation. [The above photo was taken from our observation point in Jerusalem this evening, however as we didn't see the moon, you won't find it in the photo.]

From our perspective on earth, it takes the moon an average of 29.5 days to complete its cycle. This means that the New Moon will generally be visible, either at the end of the 29th day, or at the end of the 30th day. As this was the end of the 29th day, if no positive reports come in later, tomorrow evening (7 July 2024), will be the beginning of the month by default.

On behalf of all of us who keep the Biblical Calendar, we wish to thank everyone who looked for the New Moon from Israel this evening, and all of you who are supporting this important effort from afar.



The above dates are based on, the year beginning when the healthy barley fields, in the Plains of Jericho (Jordan Valley) (Joshua 5:10-12), are Aviv in time for the men to bring an omer of their harvest to the Priest when they go up to the Temple for Chag HaMatzot (Feast of Unleavened) (Lev 23:10), and the month beginning when the crescent New Moon (Gen 1:14, Ps 104:19) has been sighted from the Land of Israel (Dt 6:1). 
