Dear Friends,

The crescent New Moon has been sighted from Israel this evening, **Wednesday**, **4 September 2024**, thus marking the beginning of the 6th Biblical month.

The New Moon was sighted from:

- Jerusalem (Rechavia) at 7:19pm by Devorah Gordon, Chaya, and one other person

The above sightings were made solely with the naked eye (unless indicated otherwise). We believe in determining the beginning of the Biblical month the way the ancient Israelites would have done it. This means, we don't use computer programs or optical aids to spot or confirm our sightings. When we share a sighting, it means that we are absolutely sure we saw the New Moon.

The photo at the top of this report was taken from our observation point in Jerusalem this evening. The arrow points to where we saw the New Moon, however I wasn't able to capture the crescent in my camera, so you won't find it in the photo (the white dot to the left of the arrow is Venus).

On behalf of all of us who keep the Biblical Calendar, we wish to thank everyone who looked for the New Moon from Israel this evening, and all of you who are supporting this important effort from afar.

As days in the Biblical Calendar are from sunset to sunset, Rosh Chodesh (the first day of the month), begins when the crescent New Moon has been sighted, and continues until sunset the following day. Rosh Chodesh a celebratory day (Num 10:10; Hosea 2:11), which was traditionally commemorated by blowing the shofar (Num 10:10; Psalm 81:4[3]), having a festive meal (1 Samuel 20:5, 24), and worshiping at the Beit HaMikdash (Temple) (Isaiah 66:23; Ezekiel 46:1-3) with a special sacrifice (Num 28:11-15; 2Chronicles 2:3; Ezra 3:4-5, Ezekiel 45:17, Ezekiel 46:6).

The above dates are based on the year beginning when the healthy barley fields, in the Plains of Jericho (Jordan Valley) (Joshua 5:10-12), are Aviv in time for the men to bring an omer of their harvest to the Priest when they go up to the Temple for Chag HaMatzot (Feast of Unleavened) (Lev 23:10); and the month begins when the crescent New Moon (Gen 1:14, Ps 104:19) has been sighted from the Land of Israel (Dt 6:1).
