Dear Friends,

We want to thank you for partnering with us to restore the Biblical Calendar, and to let you know that the crescent New Moon was sighted from Israel this evening, thus marking the beginning of the 11th Biblical month!

The crescent New Moon was spotted with the naked eye on **Thursday**, **30 January 2025**, from:

- * Jerusalem at 5:31pm by Devorah Gordon, followed by Chaya, Gil Ashendorf, and one other person
- * Bat Yam at 5:44 by Shane Diltz and Randy Cates, followed by Joe Dumond

As days in the Biblical Calendar are from sunset to sunset (Gen 1:3,8,13,19,23,31), Rosh Chodesh (the first day of the month), begins when the crescent New Moon has been sighted, and continues until sunset the following day. Rosh Chodesh a celebratory day (Num 10:10; Hosea 2:11), which was traditionally commemorated by blowing the shofar (Num 10:10; Psalm 81:4[3]), having a festive meal (1 Samuel 20:5, 24), and worshiping at the Beit HaMikdash

(Temple) (Isaiah 66:23; Ezekiel 46:1-3) with a special sacrifice (Num 28:11-15; 2Chronicles 2:3; Ezra 3:4-5, Ezekiel 45:17, Ezekiel 46:6).

The photo at the top of this report was taken from our observation point in Jerusalem this evening. However, a photo isn't proof that it's the beginning of the Biblical Month, as the crescent can be seen any time after conjunction if the optical aid is able to magnify and/or create enough contrast. Remember, only a reliable witness can testify as to whether the crescent moon was spotted with the naked eye, as the ancient Israelites would have done.

On behalf of all of us who keep the Biblical Calendar, we wish to thank everyone in Israel who looked for the crescent moon and shared their observations with us in a timely manner, and all of you who are supporting this important effort from afar.

The Biblical Calendar is a luni-solar calendar. Meaning that the beginning of the month is anchored to a particular phase of the lunar cycle, and the beginning of the year is anchored to a particular phase of the solar cycle (Gen 1:14). Further study leads us to understand that the beginning of the month, is when the crescent moon is sighted (the sign) after conjunction (the lunar phase), and that the beginning of the year is the month in which the barley is found to be Aviv (the sign) after the Spring Equilux (the solar phase). Therefore, it's our understanding that the upcoming Biblical Year will begin on 30 March 2025 (assuming the crescent moon is sighted that evening). For reference, the prior Biblical Month will begin on 1 March 2025 (assuming the crescent moon is sighted that evening), which as explained above is too early in the solar cycle (Gen 1:14) for it to be Chodesh HaAviv (month of the Aviv).
